It is hereby informed that, pursuant to the order dated 31.08.2026 in WP (Crl) 867/2024, it is mandatory to map the Prisoner ID at the time of e-filing of every criminal case before the High Court, wherever the petitioner/appellant is in custody.

In this regard, necessary modifications have been made in the system to map the Prisoner ID with the corresponding CMS Party ID during the e-filing. With effect from 01.10.2026, e-filers are instructed to mandatorily map the Prisoner ID while e-filing every criminal case before the High Court wherever the petitioner/appellant is in custody.

The Step-by-Step Guidelines for mapping the Prisoner ID at the time of filing is enclosed herewith for strict compliance.

Prisoner ID Map Option for E-Filers

As per the directions contained in the Hon'ble Court's order dated 31.08.2026 in W.P. (Crl.) No. 867/2024, the Prisoner ID must be captured at the time of filing and mapped to the corresponding CMS Party ID. This will enable the prompt identification of cases filed before the Hon'ble High Court on behalf of prisoners.

Accordingly, when e-filing criminal cases in which the petitioner/appellant is in prison, e-filers are required to enter the relevant prison details and Prisoner ID, and complete the mapping process in accordance with the step-by-step guidelines set out below.

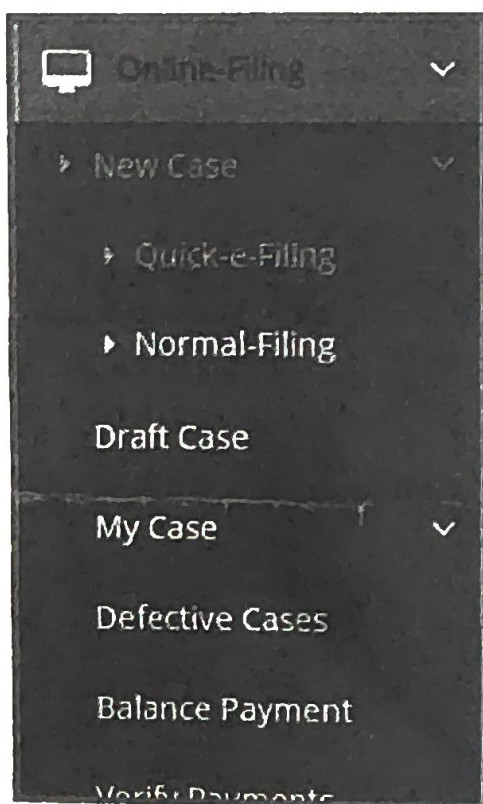

Enter the credentials used for logging in the e-filing dashboard and click on Sign in

When filing a criminal case, if the petitioner/appellant is in prison, the e-filer can select the concerned Jail and search for the required prisoner by entering the first three letters of the prisoner's name. The system will display the corresponding prisoner list based on the search criteria including FIR details.

The eFiler can select the required prisoner from the list and save the details. Upon saving, the Prisoner ID will be automatically mapped to the filed case.
